DOOR WIDTH TEMPLATE

The use of this paper template allows a quick and easy method for determining how thick a door is. 'Door Thickness', or 'door width', is a very helpful measurement to know when ordering door hardware!

STEP 1:
Print this page out your local printer.

To ensure that this printout is 'to scale', please compare the dashed circles on the left to either the size of:

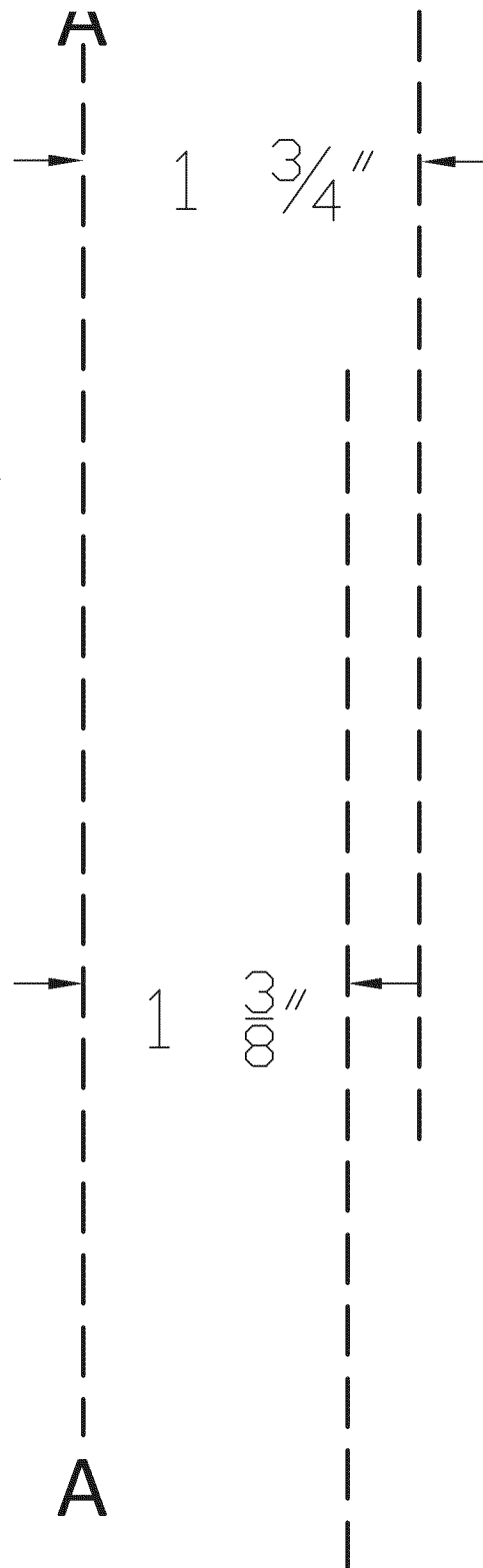
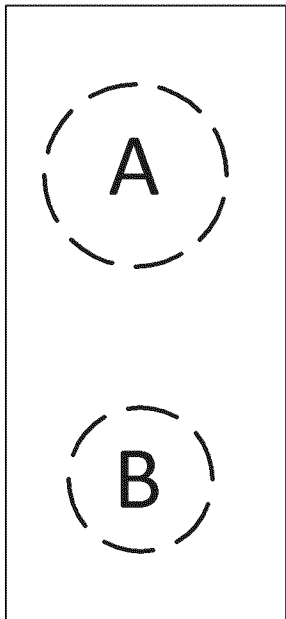
1. US Quarter 25 cent piece in circle 'A'

OR

2. US Penny 1 cent piece in circle 'B'.

The size of the circle on the paper should be the same size as the coin you are using.

After you have confirmed the scale is correct, go to STEP 2.



STEP 2:
Fold this piece of paper in half, along the dotted line marked 'A'.

Hold this piece of paper up to the door you want to measure, with the fold of the paper along the inside edge of the door.

Then, along the outside edge of the door, fold the paper again. Wherever this crease is made will show you how wide the door is; either $1 \frac{3}{8}$ " wide, or $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " wide.
